PRESENTACIÓN

En primer lugar, permítame presentarme. Mi nombre es Leoncio Carrascal y soy el nuevo presidente de esta institución europea, en reemplazo de Pedro Gómez Ruiz, desde el pasado 4 de octubre (día en que hubo elecciones en la Junta Directiva de la Red Cantábrica de Desarrollo Rural).

Al asumir mi nuevo cargo, descubrí que también debo asumir la presidencia de la Asociación PRAT-CARP, hasta 2020, cuando se debe renovar la Junta Directiva de esta asociación europea. Esta Ruta Cultural no fue una iniciativa extraña para mí, porque en mi calidad de presidente del Grupo de Acción Local Asón-Aguera-Transmiera (miembro de esta Ruta Cultural del Consejo de Europa, desde 2018), ya conocía esta red, su trabajo y su larga carrera.

Quiero agradecer a Pedro Gómez por el trabajo realizado durante los últimos 4 años al frente de PRAT-CARP CR y saludar a todos los representantes de las 42 instituciones que componen este maravilloso proyecto europeo en torno al arte rupestre europeo.

Sin duda, este año 2019 ha sido el "año de los premios a nuestra Ruta Cultural del Conseil de Europa".

PRAT-CARP CR ha recibido tres premios europeos en 2019, uno dentro del Programa de Rutas Culturales del Consejo de Europa y los otros dos por su trabajo como una red de destinos culturales.

El "Premio Europeo Carlos V", otorgado por la Fundación Academia Europea de Yuste y la Casa Real de España al Programa de Rutas Culturales del Consejo de Europa, es una de las más altas distinciones que una persona o institución puede recibir en el marco europeo y reconoce el valor europeísta de esta iniciativa creada en 1978 por el Consejo de Europa. Personalidades como Helmut Kohl, Mikhail Gorvachov, Antonio Tajani o Sofia Corradi (Programa ERASMUS) recibieron este premio en el pasado. En 2019, se otorgaron 32 rutas culturales del Consejo de Europa porque son un ejemplo del valor del diálogo intercultural y religioso en toda Europa.

El segundo premio ha sido el premio de "European Heritage Stories", un reconocimiento importante de la Comisión Europea y el Consejo de Europa que llegó con la autorización para celebrar el primer DÍA EUROPEO DEL ARTE DEL ROCK como parte de las Jornadas Europeas del Patrimonio (creado en 1991 por el Consejo de Europa). Este día especial se celebró la última fecha el 9 de octubre, como todos ustedes saben muy bien.

Finalmente, el Acuerdo Parcial Ampliado sobre Rutas Culturales del Consejo de Europa (firmado por 33 estados) ha otorgado a nuestra Ruta Cultural el "Premio a las Mejores Prácticas 2018 en Turismo Cultural y Desarrollo Sostenible" en el último FORO ANUAL DE ASESORÍA organizado en Sibiu (Rumanía) debido a nuestra ETIQUETA DE CALIDAD "European Rock Art Heritage", una buena práctica que estamos desarrollando desde 2017.

Podemos sentirnos realmente orgullosos por este año increíble y los reconocimientos que hemos obtenido. Estos premios son la confirmación de que nuestro trabajo conjunto está en la forma correcta y que nuestro futuro (trabajando juntos) puede ser realmente exitoso.

PRESENTATION

First of all, allow me to introduce myself. My name is Leoncio Carrascal and I am the new president of this European institution, replacing Pedro Gómez Ruiz, since last October 4th (day when there were elections on the Board of Directors of the Cantabrian Rural Development Network).

Assuming my new position, I found that I must also assume the presidency of the PRAT-CARP Association, until 2020, when the Board of Directors of this European association must be renewed. This Cultural Route was not a strange initiative to me, because in my capacity of president of the Asón-Aguera-Transmiera Local Action Group (member of this Cultural Route of the Council of Europe, since 2018), I already knew this network, its work and its long career.

I want to thank Pedro Gómez for the work carried out during the last 4 years at the helm of PRAT-CARP CR and greet all the representatives of the 42 institutions that make up this wonderful European project around European Rock Art.

Without doubt, this year 2019 has been the “year of the awards to our Cultural Route of the Conseil of Europe”.

There have been three European awards that PRAT-CARP CR has received in 2019, one within the Cultural Routes Program of the Council of Europe and the other two for their work as a network of cultural destinations.

The “European Award Carlos V”, awarded by the European Academy of Yuste Foundation and the Royal House of Spain to the Cultural Routes Programme of the Council of Europe, is one of the highest distinctions that a person or institution can receive within the European framework and recognizes the Europeanist value of this initiative created in 1978 by the Council of Europe. Personalities such as Helmut Kühn, Mikhail Gorvachov, Antonio Tajani or Sofia Corradi (ERASMUS Program) received this award in the past. In 2019, 32 cultural routes of the Council of Europe have been awarded because they are an example of the value of intercultural and religious dialogue across Europe.

The second award has been the award of “European Heritage Stories”, an important recognition of the European Commission and the Council of Europe that it arrived with the authorization to celebrate the first EUROPEAN DAY OF THE ROCK ART as part of the European Heritage Days (created in 1991 by the Council of Europe). This special day was celebrated last date 9th October, as all of you know very well.

Finally, the Enlarged Partial Agreement on Cultural Routes of the Council of Europe (signed by 33 states) has awarded to our Cultural Route with the “Best Practices Award 2018 in Cultural Tourism and Sustainable Development” in the last ANNUAL ADVISORY FORUM hosted in Sibiu (Romania) due to our QUALITY LABEL “European Rock Art Heritage”, a good practice that we are developing since 2017.

We can feel really proud for this amazing year and the recognitions we have obtained. These awards are the confirmation that our jointed work is in the right way and that our future (working together) may be really successful.


